Curriculum

Our topic for this term will be **The Great Fire of London**. In this topic we will spend time learning about key figures including King Charles II and Samuel Pepys. We will also explore the key events of the fire, discuss how life changed after the fire and make comparisons between life then and now.

In Science, our first focus will be **Everyday Materials**. Children will experiment and test materials and explore their suitability for different purposes.

In Autumn Term 2 we will explore **Continents and Oceans** in Geography. We will also be developing our map reading skills by using a variety of maps, atlases and globes. In Science, we will be exploring **Living Things and Their Habitats**. We will learn about different animals and how their needs are met.

PE Day

Our PE day this year will be on a **Monday**. Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing their P.E. kit on this day. PE kits should include a white or red t-shirt, navy or black shorts, trainers, navy or black jogging bottoms (only in the winter).

Homework

This year, Maths homework will be allocated through TT Rockstars. Through this, children will be able to practise fluency in multiplication facts.

English homework will be allocated through Spelling Shed where children can practise taught spelling rules.

The children will take their reading books home daily; please read at home each day and record this in your reading diary. Reading for 20 minutes a day has a massive impact!
