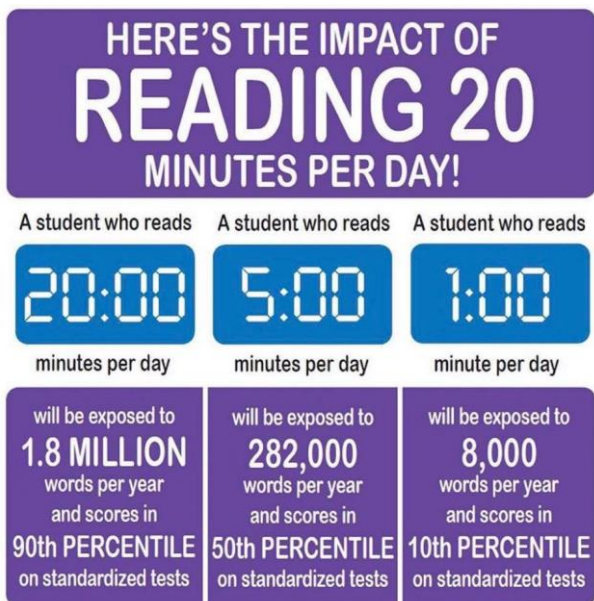
PE Day
